

Gustin's Diamond D Gelbvieh Sale Report for February 19, 2009



61 bulls averaged \$2534
19 Balancer bred heifers averaged \$1439

Gustin's Diamond D Gelbvieh was blessed with beautiful weather and a great crowd again for this year's sale.

Topping the sale was an outstanding Kuhn's Red Hemmi red Balancer, DDGR Mojave 44T, selling to the Eslinger Brothers at Elgin, ND for \$5400. Eslinger's struck again on DDGR Liberty 146T, another powerful Kuhn's Red Hemmi red Balancer out of a Dam of Distinction for \$4500. Two purebred black yearlings each topped at \$4,250. CMR Eldorado 91T, sired by the carcass sire MLH Strait Forward R89, went to Martin Gelbvieh of Rock Lake, N.D. Dale Gasho of Beach, N.D. took home DDGR Eight Ball 229T, a Red Fortunate 681 son.

Four Balancer bred heifers each sold for \$1700. Thorstenson Gelbvieh and Angus, Selby, SD, purchased DDGR Dream Girl 179T, and Rocco Schroeder of New England, ND took home DDGR Aura 222T, both outstanding Kuhn's Red Hemmi daughters. Scott Bradac of Marmarth, N.D. took home a KCF Bennett Total daughter, DDGR Honey 12T, and Rodney Meckle, Center, ND purchased DDGR Macy 23T, a BUF CRK CHF Canyon daughter.
